The seminars were coordinated by L.K.W. Wijayaratne and Dr U.G.A.I. Sirisena, Senior Lecturers respectively at the Department of Plant Sciences and the activity was funded by the department AHEAD grant.

### Awareness session on the selection of the majoring modules (2016/17 batch)

An awareness session on the selection of majoring modules in BScHons (Agri) was held on 09.11.2020 from 9.00 am to 12.30 pm using Zoom platform for the students of 2016/17 batch of the Faculty. The session was conducted successfully with the participation of 133 students in the batch. The general overview and approved guidelines for selection of a majoring module were delivered by Prof A.M.J.B. Adikari/ Dean of the Faculty while the heads of all departments presented an overview of their respective majoring modules offered by each department. This was the first time that the students selected their majoring modules using an online

platform. Therefore, the students were well aware of the google form titled, "Application for Specialization Modules - Year 3 Semester 2" prepared by the Assistant Registrar of the Faculty.

### **Training Session on Creating Quizzes and Grading in LMS**

A half-day session was held on 27.10.2020 at the faculty computer laboratory to guide the staff members on creating quizzes and grading in LMS. Mrs. Deshani Somarathne, computer instructor of the faculty served as the resource person. This training session was funded by the Faculty AHEAD grant.

# Brainstorming Session on Examination and Assessment Procedures of the Proposed Curriculum (2021-2025)

A half-day session was held on 14.10.2020 at the faculty board room to generate the comments on the proposed procedures for the examination and assessments in 2021-2025 curriculum. Dr W.C.P. Egodawatta, coordinator to the curriculum revision presented the proposed procedures and the staff members were commented critically to finalize the document to be included in the prospectus (2021-2025).

## Three-Day Learning Camp for the New Intake (2018/2019 Batch)

First three-day learning camp proposed by the AHEAD faculty DP to conduct in collaboration with the CGU of the faculty for the new intake (2018/19 batch) was conducted from 28th to 30th October 2020 at the Faculty of Agriculture, RUSL. The broad aim of this learning camp was to address the needs of fresh students and lay a very good foundation for a successful four years at the university. A total of 156 students were participated in all three days and observed that they had very productive sessions during the period. Evaluation of the program was conducted for each session separately.
