
IT Training Programme for Executive Staff Members

Plant Disease Clinic: Awareness Sessions for the Farming Community

Productivity of crop cultivation for human consumption is always at risk due to harmful organisms like pathogens, animal pests, and weeds. These crop losses have to be reduced or prevented by crop protection measures. In case of limited understanding of the science behind the disease processes and ineffective disease management; most farmers face substantial difficulties in managing plant diseases. It is required for farmers to access timely advice and actionable information on pests and diseases that affect their crops, in order to secure a more productive yield.

A similar approach to human health clinics, Plant disease clinics have been established in many countries as a novel extension approach to provide demand-driven advice for farmers to deal with pests and diseases affecting their crop production. At the plant clinic, farmers bring in "sick" plants, and plant doctors diagnose the problem using visual symptoms and the questionnaires answered by the farmers. Most of the time, the recommendations for plant diseases are mainly based on Integrated Disease Management (IDM) principles as the basis for sustainable agriculture intensification. In addition to solving Plant health problems, data gained through the Plant disease clinics are always useful in supporting pest surveillance and alerts, identifying extension and research needs and priorities, testing farmers' indigenous concepts, and identifying knowledge gaps and training needs.

With the purpose of initiation step to establish this kind of Plant Disease clinic in local setup, three awareness programmes on plant diseases were conducted on 11th March 2022 at Weherathanna village and 17th June 2022 at Athawetunuwewa and KiriIbbanwewa villages, Mahaweli system "L", Anuradhhapura, Sri Lanka by the Department of Plant Sciences, Faculty of Agriculture, Rajarata University of Sri Lanka with the collaboration of Mahaweli Authority. The entire programme was sponsored by the AHEAD Project of the university.

Those programmes were comprehended through presentations, discussions as well as visualizations of posters. The special focus was drawn to discuss pests and diseases of Rice, Fruits, Vegetables, and floricultural plants, post-harvest diseases, Nutrient management, biological control of Plant diseases, Pesticides application, etc. During

the programme, discussions were centered on identifying the plant problems encountered by the farmers. Further, soil samples of their fields were tested for pH and gave the required guidance to maintain proper soil health. In addition, disease-infected or pest-attacked plant parts were collected for further clarification through laboratory testing.

The participants expressed interest in learning more about disease management and adopting the given recommendations. The novel knowledge and the research findings were disseminated to the participants. Mainly research findings related to biological control agents: *Trichoderma virens*, plant disease control, and nutrient management in paddy cultivation were discussed. The farmers were enthusiastic about adopting biological disease control products that we introduced to them. Moreover, the participants were impassioned to observe the provided plant pathogens including culture plates that cause plant diseases. Those clinics were conducted with the financial assistance through AHEAD / RA 2 / ELTAELST / RUSL / SOA / DPS / OVAA / 7 department project. Mrs. TDC Priyadarshani, Senior Lecturer at the Department of Sciences took the responsibility of organizing this event with the support of teaching assistants at the Department of Plant Sciences. 




Workshop on "Crafting Research Proposals and Presentations"



The second session of the workshop was conducted by Dr. Sriyan Jayasuriya, Senior Environmental Scientist, Canterbury, New Zealand on 'Organized Reasoning in Literature Review'. In this session, the topics such as key components of a literature review, arguments, mind map, references, and plagiarism were discussed. Ms. Malika Piyarathne at the Department of Plant Sciences coordinated this workshop.

One day workshop on commercializable TMR briquettes for farmers involved in the dairy business was successfully organized by the Research team under AHEAD DOR 39. 
Awareness Session on the Management Information System of the Faculty




Library Awareness Session on Effective use of Library Facilities

Inauguration Ceremony for New Entrants (2020/2021 Batch)


The virtual inauguration ceremony to welcome the new intake of students in the 2020/2021 batch (22nd batch of students) to the faculty was held on 16th August 2022.

Awareness session on LMS for the New Entrants in 2020/2021 Batch





The same session was repeated by Dr. D.A.U.D. Devasinghe on 22nd December 2022 and 12 academic staff members of the faculty participated.








Workshop on "Personal Wellbeing of an Undergraduate"


