Training workshop on modern practices in human resource management, university administration and financial management



participated to represent the government and private sectors. Fourty eight academic members of the faculty participated in this discussion.














Staff training session on using assessment blueprint and rubrics



Visit of Prof. Zhou Deyi, Zuazhong Agriculture University, China










Workshop on Quality Management in Agriculture Degree Programme and SER writing
